CIPCT Quick Facts

The University of Washington operates on a Quarter System. Autumn Quarter 2011 runs September 28 - December 9, with finals December 12-16.

All CIPCT students are required to attend the Annual CIPCT Meeting – a 2-3 day session at the UW Seattle campus each year. These sessions are scheduled over the weekend prior to the beginning of the Autumn quarter.

For every credit taken, expect up to 3 hours of coursework per week. A 9 credit course load will require approximately 27 hours of work per week.

Full-Time or Part-Time?
Which option is best for you?

Full-Time

Full-time students can complete the program in 5-6 quarters and usually do not work while enrolled. The workload is heavier in Year 1, and tapers off as students complete required course work and focus on the project in Year 2.

Part-Time

Part-time students can complete the program in 2-2.5 years, with an average quarterly workload of 6-8 credits. Most part-time students maintain full or part-time employment while enrolled.

Budgeting for Graduate School

- ✓ Additional expenses for online programs

- ✓ Text Books and Software – Be sure to include text books and the purchase of current software in your budget. Anti-virus software and Microsoft Office 2010 are available at no cost to matriculated students. Discounts are available on other programs, such as EndNote.
- ✓ Future course fees – Course fees are projected to increase by 6-8% annually. Add a percentage increase to your projections when planning your finances.

Additional Student Fees – Current Fees for 2010-2011

Student Health Fee: A once-per-program fee of approximately \$300 charged in the student's first Autumn Quarter.

Services & Activities Fee: This fee supports student activities and programs such as ASUW and GPSS Activities, Student Loan Fund, Hall Health Primary Care Center, student legal services, Ethnic Cultural Center, etc. This fee is approximately \$150 per quarter.

Technology Fee: This fee supports the improvement of technology used by the UW students. The Student Technology Fee Committee allocates money for technology resources for general student use. Paid Autumn, Winter, and Spring Quarters, this fee is estimated at \$50 per quarter.

Registration Fee: A nonrefundable \$35 fee is charged each quarter at the time of registration.
